Take a guided tour of the Gettysburg Battlefield

DAY 1 – Arrive in Pennsylvania

Arrive in Philadelphia today and transfer to your hotel. Meet your Tour Manager and fellow travelers at 6:00 p.m. for a welcome dinner. **Meal: D**

DAY 2 – Touring Historic Philadelphia

Begin the day at the new Museum of the American Revolution which traces the history and creation of the American Republic. Then a local guide joins you for a tour of this historic city to see the Liberty Bell, Congress Hall, Benjamin Franklin's home and Independence Hall. You also visit Betsy Ross' home for a look into the life of America's most famous flag-maker followed by the National Constitution Center. Here, see the multimedia theater-in-the-round performance Freedom Rising as well as the hands-on exhibit The Story of We The People. Tonight, dinner is at City Tavern which was established in 1773 and is where the nation's founding fathers dined, drank and celebrated. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 3 – Valley Forge and Gettysburg

A day filled with history begins with a stop at Valley Forge National Historic Park. Learn how General George Washington's Continental Army successfully engaged the British army at the Battle of Monmouth. In Gettysburg, lunch is at the Dobbin House Tavern, the oldest building in Gettysburg, which features historic furnishings and costumed wait staff. At the Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor Center see the Morgan Freeman-narrated feature film A New Birth of Freedom, which orients you to the Battle of Gettysburg and the American Civil War. See the restored Cyclorama painting, the Battle of Gettysburg, and be surrounded by the fury of "Pickett's Charge" in this one-of-a-kind panoramic experience. There is nothing quite like standing on the actual battlefield at Gettysburg. A licensed Gettysburg guide

DAY 4 – Lancaster and The Total Amish Experience

Travel today to the beautiful Pennsylvania Dutch region to the heart of the Amish Countryside. Enjoy the "Total Amish Experience" today for an entertaining and educational overview of Amish culture with a local guide. See the farms, one-room schools and other aspects of Amish life, with one or two stops at Amish farms for foods and crafts. Your all-you-can-eat feast at Lancaster's first family-style restaurant will feature many local specialties, from golden fried chicken and sausage to shoofly pie and ice cream. At Plain & Fancy, you'll see the acclaimed Jacob's Choice, a five-screen special effects show about growing up Amish and the journey from Europe to America in search of religious freedom. The nine-room Heritage Site Amish Country Homestead & One-Room School gives you an inside look at eight-grades-in-a-room education, as well as Plain clothing and life without electricity. Experience it all in the oldest and largest Amish settlement in the world.


DAY 5 – Nemours Mansion, Longwood Gardens and Brandywine Valley

Venture into the State of Delaware for a visit to the opulent Nemours Mansion and Gardens. The former estate of Alfred du Pont, the inventor of smokeless gunpowder, this classical French Chateau was built in 1910, has 105 rooms and is filled with antiques, art and tapestries from the 1700s. Back in Pennsylvania a visit to beautiful Longwood Gardens is planned. Saved from destruction in 1906 by Pierre du Pont, Long-

wood is one of the nation's premier botanical gardens and consists of 1,100 acres of gardens, woodlands and meadows. Leave behind the scenic Brandywine Valley and return to Philadelphia for a farewell dinner hosted by your Tour Manager. **Meals: B, D**

DAY 6 – Travel Home

After breakfast, a group transfer to the Philadelphia Airport is available for flights out after 10:00 a.m. **Meal: B**

By using Mayflower's air services, you accept that Mayflower is only acting as your agent and is not responsible for any accident, death, personal injury, illness, property damage, delay or other monetary loss or expense of any nature that may arise directly or indirectly out of any act of God, or any actions or default of any carrier. Mayflower is not liable for, and does not assume responsibility or accept claims with regards to any losses incurred due to cancellation of flights or change in flight schedule resulting in additional expenses to you, even when the air services are purchased through Mayflower.

Tour Price Includes: All motorcoach transportation noted in the tour itinerary, round trip airport transfers on the tour departure and return dates (only), services of the Tour Manager and driver, lodging, sightseeing, taxes, admissions, gratuities for bellmen and waiters for included meals, as well as future travel credits. Included meals are clearly noted in the touring description. Air transportation is available upon request, at additional cost, for United States and Canada Tours. For travelers purchasing their own air, airport transfers are included provided their flight arrival and departure times meet the time frames suggested in the brochure.

What is Not Included on the Tours: The land price of your tour does not include airfare to the tour departure point; excess luggage charges; items of a personal nature; meals not included on the itinerary; sightseeing attractions listed as "optional excursions" and gratuities to the full time Tour Manager, motorcoach driver, all airport skycaps, van or limo drivers and local guides.

Airline Security Measures: The Transportation Security Administration requires that travelers provide their name exactly to their airline as it appears on the passport or a government issued I.D. (such as a drivers license) to be used while traveling, along with their date of birth and gender when making reservations to fly within the U.S. When making your flight reservations through Mayflower Tours, you will be asked for this information by our staff. Due to airline security measures, your photo I.D. or passport must match your airline ticket name and your tour reservation name or you may be denied aircraft boarding.

Passport & Visas for Canada and Mexico: Each U.S. citizen must have a valid passport for entry into Canada or Mexico. No other documents will be accepted. Expiry date of passports should be at least six months after the return date of tour. If you don't have a passport, call our office and we'll tell you how to apply for one. Holders of non-U.S. passports should contact their nearest consulate and inquire about the necessary passport or visa documentation required for entry into the countries visited.
